



Strong European data protection rules to boost the digital economy




72% of Internet users in Europe still worry that they are being asked for too much **personal data online**








State of Play of Interoperability in EU

There is an overall very good NIF-EIF alignment across countries for 2014




Still some way to go to have it implemented


interaction between European public administrations. ... share and reuse existing successful or new Interoperability solutions, common services and generic tools. ...IT systems allow smooth implementatio n of Community policies and The ISA² programme shall **facilitate** efficient and effective electronic **cross-border or cross-sector** interaction between **European** public administrations and between them and citizens and businesses.

- Will run from 2016 until 2020, aligned with the Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF)
- Will have a financial envelope of approx. 131 M€
- Will receive proposals from Member States and Commission services
- Will be executed by the European Commission






