- **Maintenance and Implementation Framework (MIF)** set up by the Commission, in agreement with the Member States
- **Coordinated** by Commission Expert Group on INSPIRE Maintenance & Implementation (**MIG**) with representatives of the Member States
  - Technical and policy sub-groups (MIG-T and MIG-P)
- Following a rolling **work programme (MIWP)**
- MIWP actions executed through **temporary sub-groups**
- Supported by a **pool of** INSPIRE implementation **experts**
