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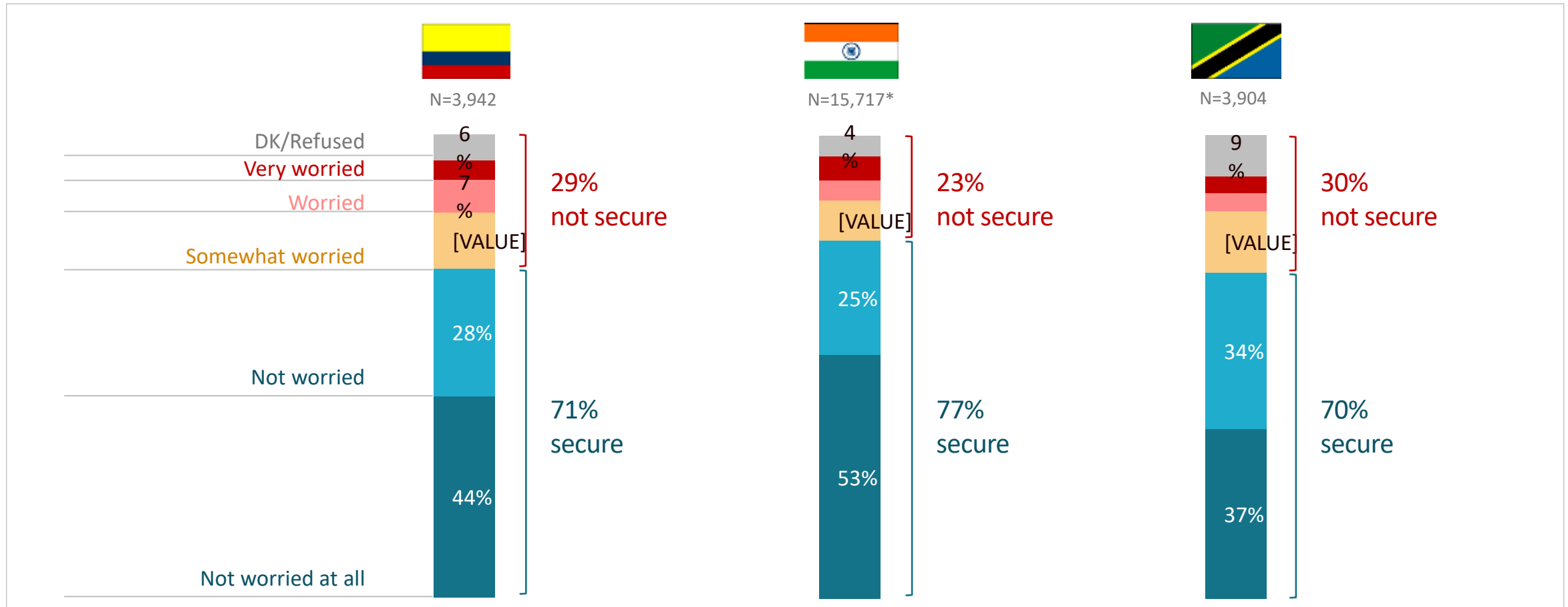
What is PRIndex?

- A global and national-level baseline of peoples' perceptions of their land tenure security
- Data source for SDG indicator 1.4.2.
- Success with PRIndex will:
 - give voice to billions without property rights
 - create an evidence base for policy-making around property rights
 - act as a transparent and public score card for countries to see how they are faring
 - provide justification for more investment to flow into this space



Worry about losing right to live in property/dwelling in the next 5 years

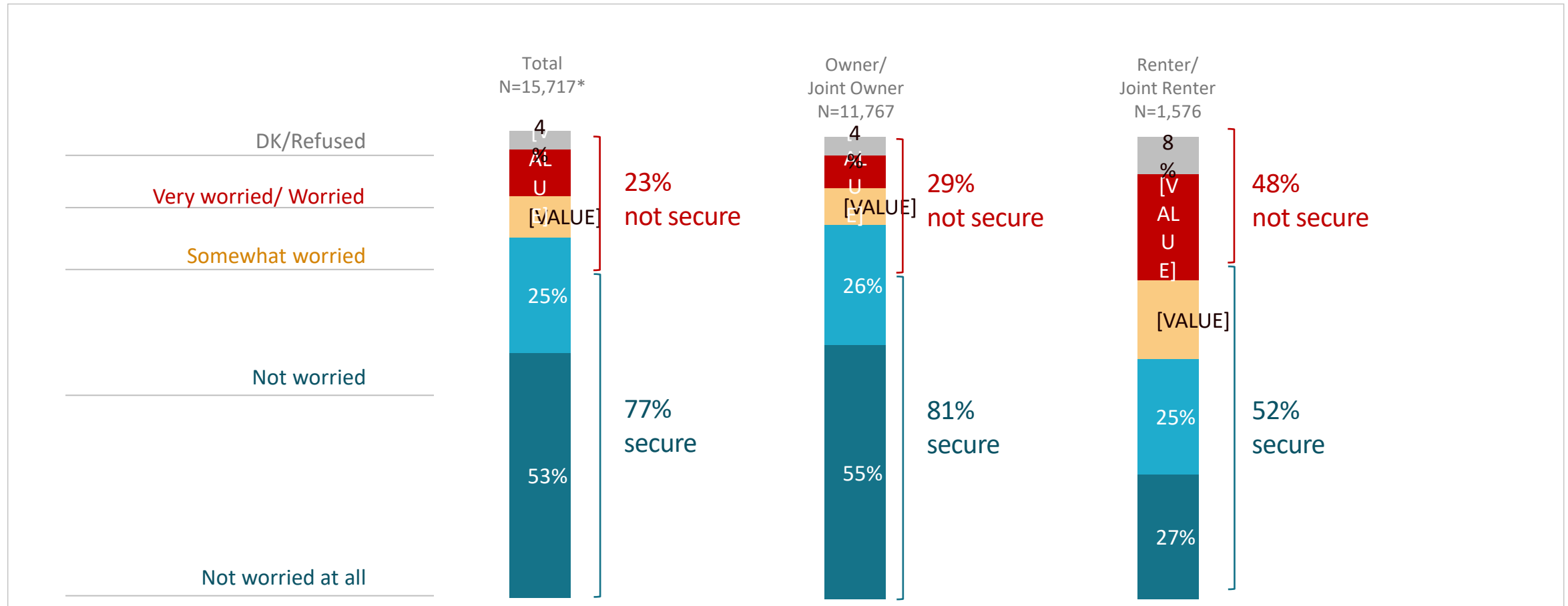
This question has the lowest proportion of DK/Refused (particularly noticeable in TZ). Similar to 4.2, CO and TZ trail IN in perceived security, though they are closer. Most of the worried express only doubt (somewhat worried), while a relatively low proportion feel very worried/worried.





India: Tenure Security by Tenure Type

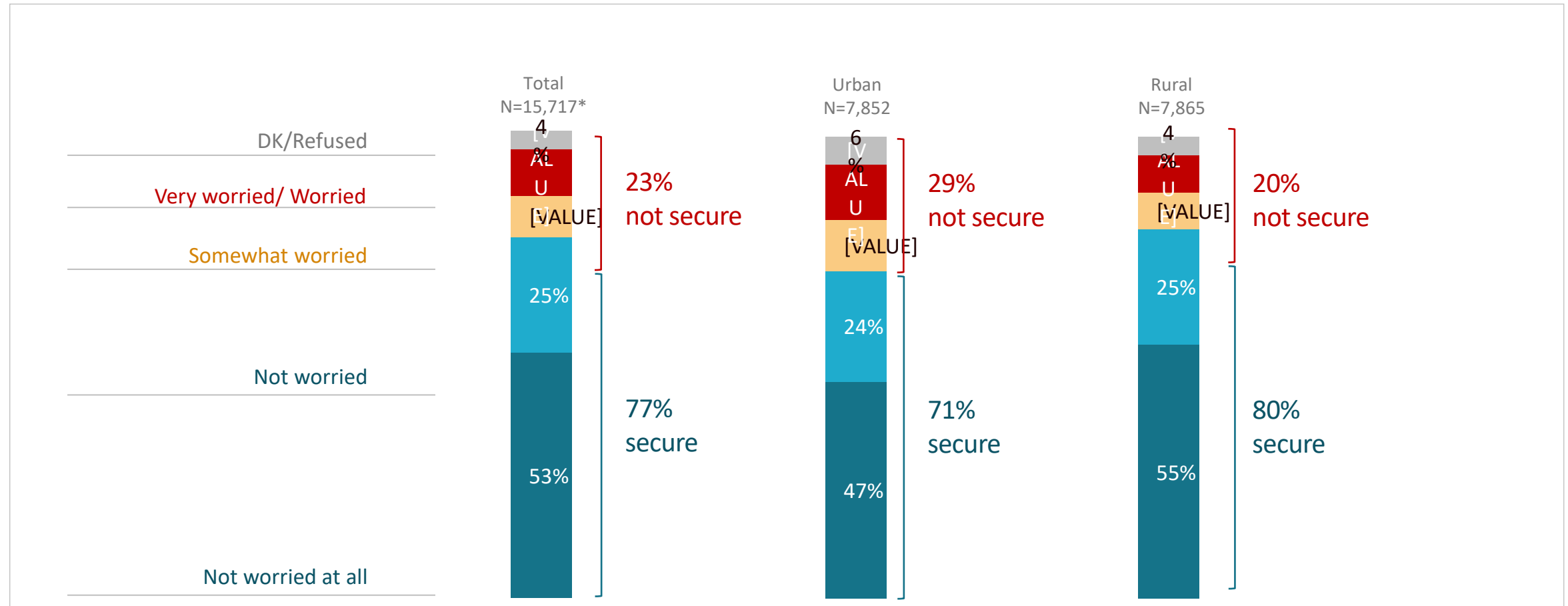
Four in ten renters are insecure and nearly half are not secure. In contrast, more than eight in ten owners are secure.





India: Tenure Security by Urban vs. Rural

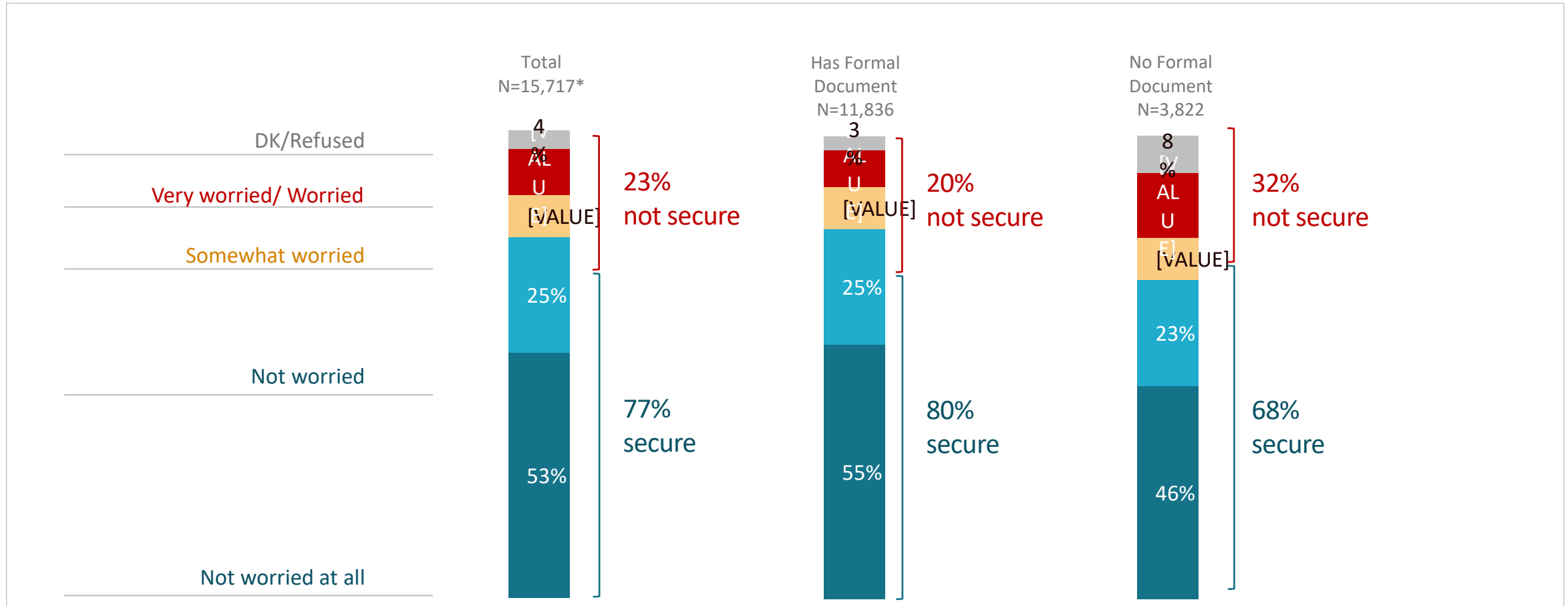
Rural Indians expressed a higher level of security than urban Indians, probably because the incidence of renting is higher in urban areas.





Tenure Security by Formal Documentation

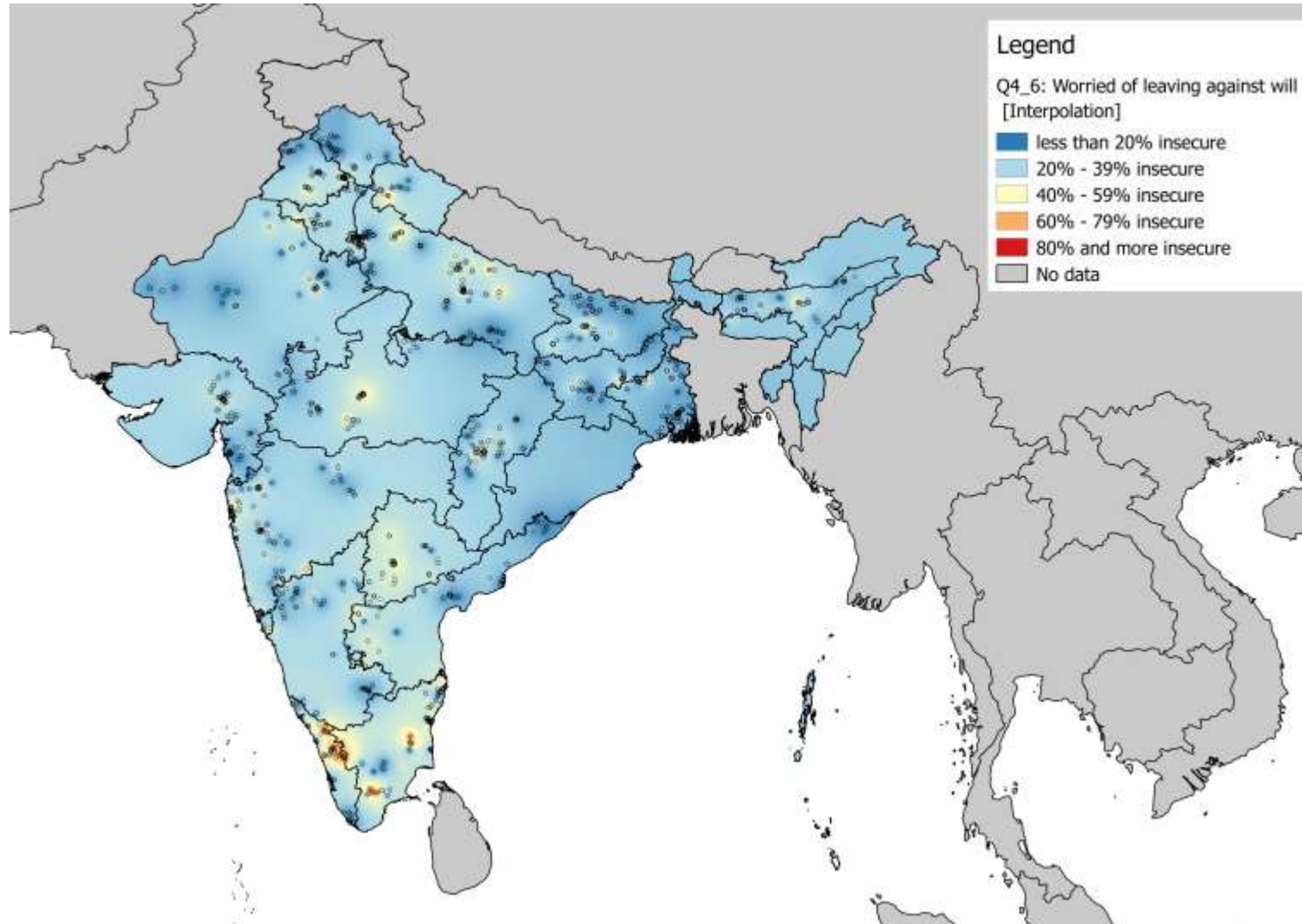
Those without formal documents are considerably less secure than those who have them.



Geography of the Tenure Insecure



States of Tamil Nadu, Telangana, and Kerala have a higher concentration of respondents who are worried about losing their property against their will.
